P7 Transition 2020

Dear Parent/Carer

I am pleased to be writing to you about the arrangements for the P7 visit to Gryffe High School in June 2020.

All P7 pupils who will be joining Gryffe High School in August 2020 have been invited to visit the school in small groups as part of their preparation for next session. The dates, days and times have been issued by your child's Primary School. Pupils will have the opportunity to attend two lessons and will meet with me, their Guidance Teacher and the Head Teacher during their visit.

Pupils who wish to take up this invitation are asked to arrive at school between 8.50am and 9.00am for the morning session and 12.20pm – 12.30pm if they have been allocated an afternoon session. The Head Teacher and I will meet pupils at the front door as they arrive and reinforce social distancing and hygiene messages in line with health and safety policy. Pupils will then be taken to the school theatre. From there pupils will be divided into small groups for the morning's/afternoon's activities.

The practical arrangements for these induction days are as follows:

- Pupils should wear their P7 Leavers Hoodie or their current school uniform. They will not require PE kit for their induction visit.
- Pupils should make their own way to and from Gryffe High School. They should arrive between at the times stated above depending if they have been allocated a morning or afternoon session
The morning session end at 11.30am. The afternoon session ends at 3.00pm
- We do not intend to have a break or interval. However, pupils can bring a bottle of water with them. Currently there are no facilities to refill a water bottle.
- Please note that adults should not accompany children into the school building.
- Pupils do not need to bring any equipment with them other than a pencil. Any other materials required for lessons will be provided.

I hope the transition arrangements described above and the June on-line P7 virtual classroom experience has helped to ensure that your child's transfer from primary school to Gryffe High School is a positive and enjoyable experience.
